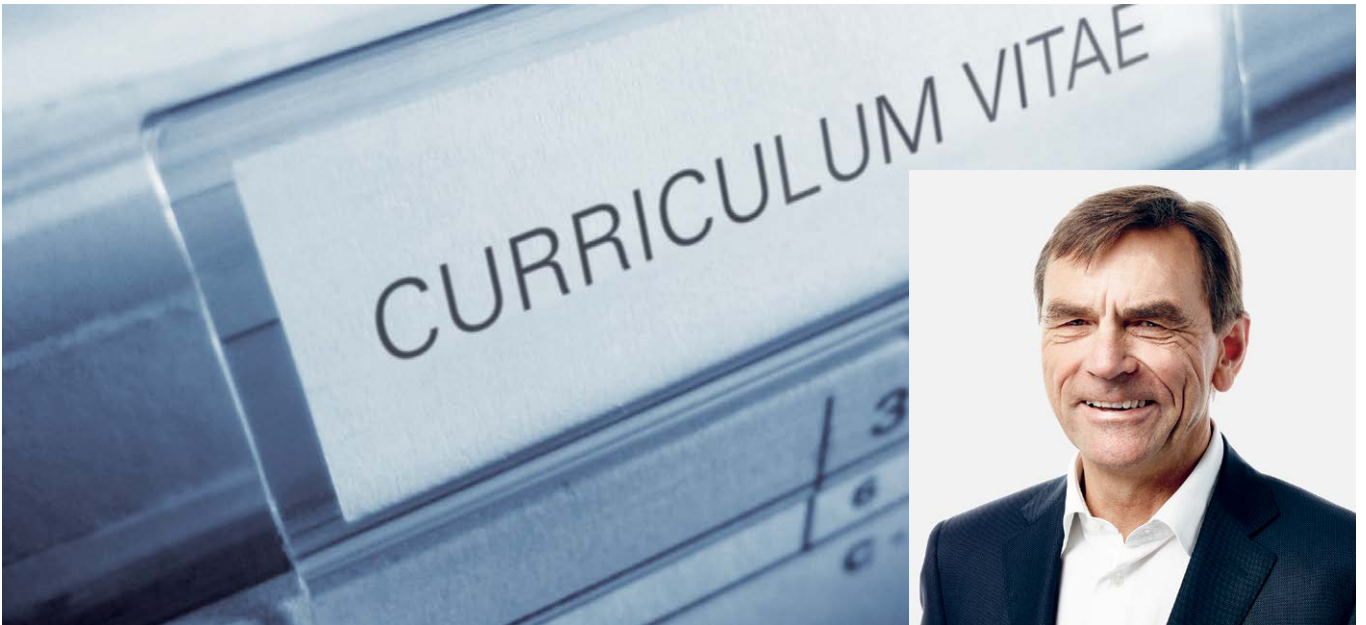

Hans Isler is a Swiss citizen, born in 1953. He has been a member of the Board of Directors since 2012, and was re-elected on 28 March 2018 for a term of one year.

Previously, he was a partner at Arthur Andersen from 1994 until 2002, and at Ernst & Young from 2002 until 2011. From 1986 to 2011, he led audits of regulated entities in Switzerland, including banks, funds, fund managers and securities dealers.

He is also Chairman of the Board of Directors of Banque Thaler SA, Geneva, and member of the Board of Directors of Banque Pictet & Cie SA, Carouge, Geneva; Banque du Léman SA, Geneva; Valcourt SA, Geneva; MKS (Switzerland) SA, Geneva and PAMP SA, Castel San Pietro. In addition, he is a member of the finance commission of MSF (Médecins Sans Frontières) and a member of the Geneva Court of Audit.
