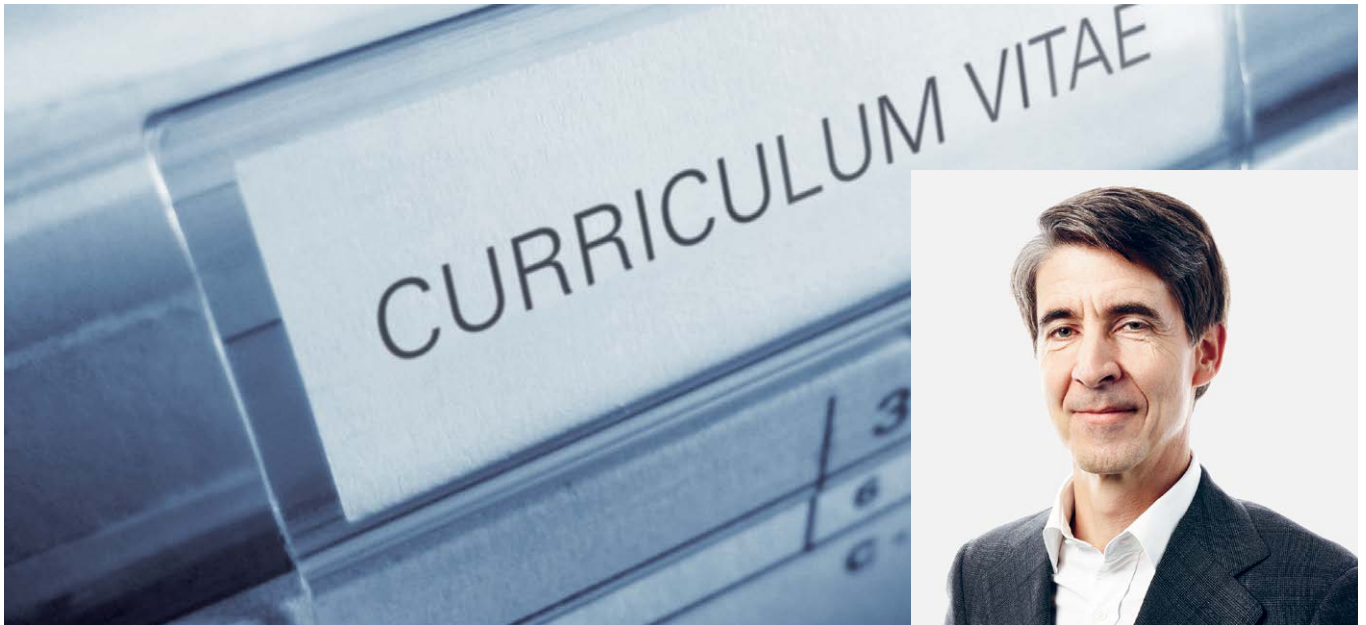

Jörg Behrens is a German citizen, born in 1964. He has been a member of the Board of Directors since 2012, and was re-elected on 28 March 2018 for a term of one year.

He is currently the managing partner and Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of Fintegral AG, which he founded in 2009. From July 2002 until March 2009, he was a partner at Ernst & Young Ltd, Switzerland, and held various functions, including Head of Financial Risk Management Central Europe and Global Head of Risk Analytics. Since June 2001 he has been Vice Chairman of Stiftung Buechweid, Russikon, and since May 2010 he is a member of the Board of Directors of Mathfinance AG, Germany.

Jörg Behrens holds a doctorate in physics from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) Zurich for his research in particle physics at LEP/CERN and a Master's degree in nuclear physics from ETH.
