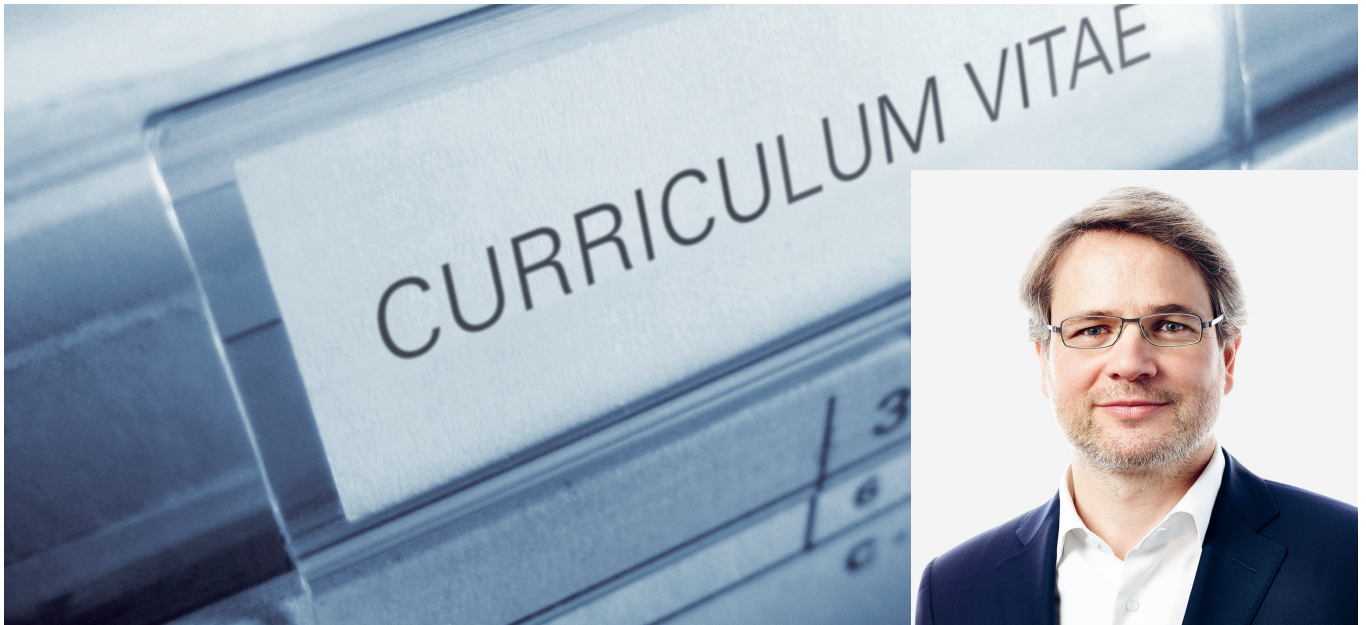

Lukas Rufin is a Swiss citizen, born in 1975. Since May 2018 he is CEO. Prior to becoming CEO he was a member of the Board of Directors since 2009.

He was Deputy CEO and an executive committee member of EFG International from 2009 to 2012. He was one of EFG Financial Products' Founding Partners in 2007, and was responsible for setting up and managing the issuing operations in Guernsey as General Manager of EFG Financial Products (Guernsey) Limited, from 2007 to 2009. In addition, he also served as a Director of EFG Investment (Luxembourg) S.A., Luxembourg, from 2007 to 2010 and as CEO of EFG Bank Ltd, Zurich (2010), in parallel to his functions at EFG International. Before joining EFG Financial Products, he held various management positions at EFG Bank and EFG International in Zurich and London, including Deputy CFO of EFG International Group. He started his career at Lehman Brothers, going on to J.P. Morgan and Pricewaterhouse Coopers before joining EFG in 2004.

Lukas Rufin holds a Master's degree in economics from the University of St. Gallen and a CEMS Master's degree in international management also from the University of St. Gallen.
